## *Gurdwara Godri Sahib*



Gurdwara Godri Sahib has a unique history. Baba Farid Ji visited this place in the year 1215 AD while going to Pak Pattan from Delhi. He stayed at this place with his fellow travellers onto the bank of a pond and put his clothes on a tree, then proceeded to the city to collect food. The city was situated nearby and was under construction. Baba Farid Ji was mistaken for a bonded labourer and compelled to work. But the Basket (tokri) he was carrying miraculously floated in the air above his head. Witnessing this miracle, the king himself came and sought forgiveness. Then, the king released all the bonded labourers. The place where Baba Farid Ji was caught for bonded labour is now known as 'Tilla Baba Sheikh Farid Ji'. After his return to the place, where he had left his godri, he noticed that his godri was being used by some children as a ball. Realizing his fault for being careless with something gifted by his Guru Bakhtiar Kaki, Baba Farid Ji felt deep remorse. He then meditated for 40 days at this place. Thereafter, he delivered his sermons here, and the people started recognizing this place as Godri Sahib.

## *Academic Discipline*

- \* Students are expected to maintain discipline, decorum, and contribute positively to the academic environment of the college. Mutual respect, dignity, and a spirit of friendship are essential to fostering a harmonious student community.
- \* Attendance in lectures, tutorials, practicals, and all curricular activities is mandatory. Each student is assigned a faculty mentor or class coordinator, responsible for monitoring academic performance and communicating with parents if a student has frequent absences, which may hinder their adaptation to the college environment.
- \* As per the university ordinance, students must maintain at least 75% attendance in each subject per semester to be eligible for university examinations. Failure to meet the required attendance may result in detention in one or more subjects, following the norms of Punjabi University, Patiala, and the Bar Council of India, New Delhi.
- \* Lecture condonation policies are subject to the regulations of Punjabi University, Patiala, and the Bar Council of India, New Delhi.

## *General Rules of Discipline*

- \* Students must carry their college-issued ID card at all times.
- \* Proper college uniform is mandatory.
- \* The college will take disciplinary action in accordance with its rules and regulations regarding curricular and co-curricular activities, whether independently or based on formal complaints from faculty or students.
- \* Mobile phone usage is strictly prohibited during lectures, in the library, corridors, and staircases.
- \* Students are not permitted to enter faculty rooms without prior permission from faculty members.

- \* Damage to college property is a serious offence. Any student responsible will face disciplinary action, including monetary fines, recovery of damage costs, and possible expulsion.



- \* Students must regularly check the college's notice board for updates. The college is not obligated to provide information individually.
- \* The college is not responsible for matters related to university examinations, mark sheets, late fees, form rejections, question papers outside the syllabus, etc.
- \* In case of serious illness during college hours, the administration will inform the student's guardian.
- \* Students must adhere to rules and regulations established by the University, State Government, Bar Council of India (BCI), and the College Authorities, which may be updated at any time.
- \* The college reserves the right to add or modify rules and regulations as needed, without prior notice.
- \* Students must not form or join any association or club related to the college without prior approval from the Principal.
- \* The use of tobacco products (cigarettes, pan masala, gutka, etc.), alcohol, and all intoxicants is strictly prohibited on campus and in surrounding areas.
- \* Students must maintain discipline both inside and outside the campus, follow all rules, and not disrupt teaching or administration. Violations may result in strict disciplinary action.

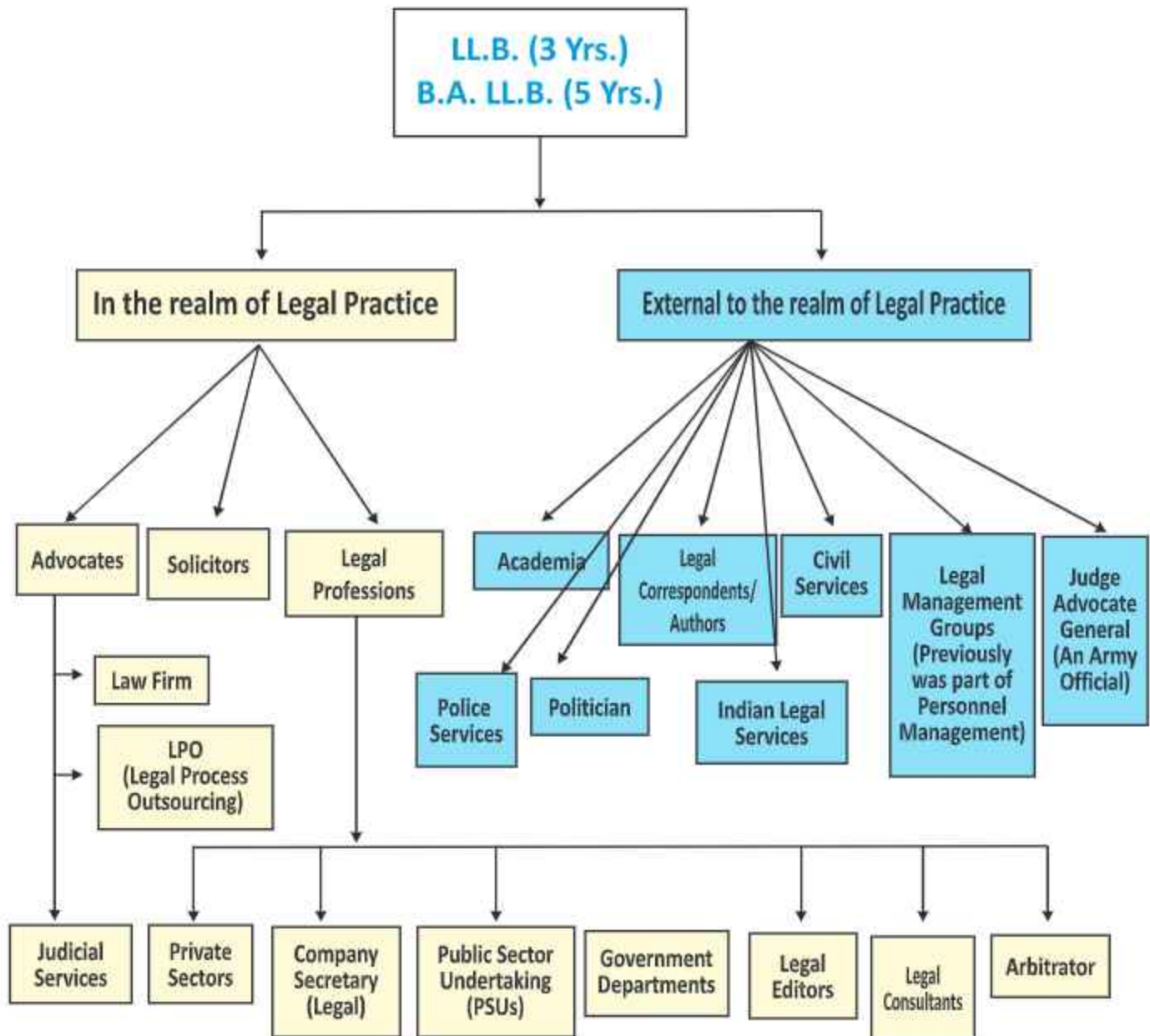
